## **EMO Western States Championship Show Qualifiers**

The EMO Agency and the Western States Affiliates\* would like to congratulate you on your accomplishment of qualifying through your state affiliate for the EMO Western States Championship Show. The EMO Western States Championship show is July 4–9, 2017 at South Point Equestrian Center in Las Vegas, Nevada. Beautiful Gold, Silver and Bronze Trophies will be awarded from 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place in all Championship classes.

Your affiliate's rules require that you are a current member and have competed in at least one approved show in the classes you enter at the EMO Western States Championship between January 1, 2016 and March 31, 2017. **You must provide a show record indicating which classes you are qualified to compete in (send in with entry form).** If you have questions about the classes in which you are qualified, please contact your state affiliate.

Your class list, tentative schedule, entry form and stall reservation form to the EMO Western States Championship Show are included in this packet. Hotel reservation information is also included. **Entries for the EMO Western States Championship classes and payment must be received with your entry by show secretary Heidi Lane no later than June 10, 2017.**

There will also be a 10 Judge AQHA approved show (The Celebration) held in conjunction with the EMO Western States Championship, June 29 – July 9, 2017. The Celebration AQHA circuit is open to all exhibitors - you do not need to have qualified to show in these AQHA classes. A class schedule and entry form for the AQHA classes is also included. You must enter the AQHA approved classes by June 20, 2017 or late fees apply. Note: Cattle classes must be entered and paid for by June 15.
