EHV-1 / Health Requirements

All horses will be required to have a health certificate that is dated no more than 7 days from the start of the sale. On the health certificate the veterinarian is required to include a statement saying “The horses listed on this health certificate are not currently showing any clinical signs of EHV-1, have a normal temperature, and have not been exposed to an EHV-1 positive horse nor have they been stabled in an EHV-1 quarantined county.” **Sale horses must be vaccinated for EHV-1 no less than 14 days or more than 30 days prior to the sale.** Recommended vaccines are Pneumabort-K or Calvenza. The vaccination record must also be written on the health certificate which will include the date administered, brand, and serial number.
