

Texas Quarter Horse Association Foundation Youth Scholarship Application

The TQHA Foundation (TQHAF) Scholarships support TQHYA members in their pursuit of higher education making that education more affordable. Since the Foundation's inception, more than \$300,000 in TQHAF Scholarships have been awarded. Recipients are selected based on *active* participation in TQHYA, TQHA, AQHA or other equine activities with an emphasis on leadership; strong academic credentials; financial need; demonstrated leadership in school and community organizations; and effective communication skills. Successful candidates must demonstrate a history of TQHYA/TQHA participation while promoting its programs in a meaningful way and be considered a role model for TQHYA's objectives of high moral character and sportsmanship among its members.

To be eligible, candidates must have been a TQHYA or TQHA member since January 1, 2022, have a 3.0 minimum grade point average (GPA) and apply during their senior year of high school or while enrolled at an accredited college, university, or vocational school. Previous TQHAF scholarship recipients are not eligible.

TQHAF Scholarships are to be used for undergraduate studies at an accredited college, university, or vocational institution as a full-time student. Scholarships are typically four or two-year awards, with annual payments to the institution, and continuation is subject to the recipient maintaining full-time student status and a 2.5 minimum GPA.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. TQHYA or TQHA member in good standing since January 1, 2022
 - a. Membership requirements will increase to minimum three-year membership for 2025 awards.
- 2. Senior in high school or while enrolled at an accredited college, university, or vocational school but must apply within two years of high school graduation date.
- 3. Cumulative high school and post high school (if applicable) minimum 3.0 grade point average (4.0 scale)
- 4. United States citizen and residency in the State of Texas
- 5. Current or previous recipients of a TQHAF scholarship are not eligible

Scholarship Application, including ALL supporting materials and reference letters must be received by TQHA no later than January 6. The applicant must provide:

- 1. Completed, signed Scholarship Application prepared by the applicant
- 2. TQHYA or TQHA membership card copy
- 3. An essay, not to exceed 1,000 words explaining:
 - a. Applicant's career and educational goals and other topics you wish to convey to the Committee
 - b. Applicant's financial need, including estimated costs and anticipated use of funds
- 4. Official transcripts High school transcript (grades 10 11 is mandatory, grade 12 to extent available on date of application). If applicable, an official "post high school" transcript should be included.
- 5. Three letters of Reference, including:
 - a. 1) A teacher and 2) a person familiar with the applicant's equine activities.
 - b. TQHYA Youth Advisors may serve as one of the references but will also provide independent input on all applicants to the Scholarship Committee.

Application Submission: All application materials must be received by TQHA office by January 6. If the application is emailed, it must be submitted from the **applicant's personal email**. Reference letters must be submitted directly to TQHA by the individual making the recommendation either from the referral source's personal email or US postal service and must also be received by the January 6 deadline.

Selection Process: Recipients of TQHAF scholarships are chosen by the TQHAF Scholarship Committee and TQHAF Board of Directors based on reviews of the submitted applications and interviews with applicants. Recipients will be notified by March 15 and will include specific guidelines for requesting payment. The first scholarship disbursements will begin with the fall semester following award notification.
